↔ Who We Are

PCLC is a Christian early childhood center that offers affordable preschool and childcare, part-time and full-time, for children who are 3, 4, and 5 years of age. Our curriculum runs year-round.

Our learning environment focuses on helping children grow and develop not only academically, but emotionally, socially, physically, and spiritually as well.

↔ Our Facility

Our classrooms were designed and built with preschoolers in mind! They include a carpeted play area, art & activities tables, computer-center and child-size restrooms. Our outdoor play area is located near our classrooms and includes an age-appropriate playground, swings, and sandbox.

For children who stay with us for the full day, we have a special lunchroom where a healthy hot lunch is provided. Naptime takes place in a separate child-friendly room, where the children rest on their own cot.

↔ Registration

Registration is accomplished by submitting a completed registration form to the preschool or church office, along with a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.

↔ All in a Day

Using Illinois Early Learning Standards and Christian principles as our guide, our curriculum is customized especially for PCLC, and is pulled from many resources. It is organized around multiple learning centers with an understanding that play is an important tool in the process of learning.

Jesus Time

- Bible stories, song of praise, prayers and chapel once a month.

Group Time

- Stories, calendar, weather, sharing and music lessons.

Learning Center Time

- Developing cognitive abilities through hands-on learning and exploration.
- Learning and developing manipulative, language, and other related skills.
- Understanding mathematical concepts and developing a sense of order.
- Integrating literacy, science, social studies and fine arts to begin learning about the world around us and how we relate to people in it.

Art Time

- Exploring various forms of art media, promoting creativity & developing fine motor skills.



Play Time

- Developing gross motor skills, physical fitness, and social skills.

Snack Time

- Eating and giving thanks.
- Developing an understanding of health and food groups.

↔ Programs

Full-Day Program – 5 Days: Monday through Friday 7am-6pm

- Morning Preschool Program is included.
- Breakfast and hot lunch are provided.
- **\$195 per week** (all 5 days) or a **\$45 daily fee** (if less than 5 days a week).
- Limited financial aid will be available on a need-basis for the full-time program only.

Preschool 3 & 4's Half-Day – 3 Days: Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays

- AM 9:00am-11:30am or PM 12:45pm-3:15pm
- **\$160 per month**
- Children must turn 3 on or before September 1st of the current school year.

Preschool 4 & 5's Half-Day – 4 Days: Tuesday through Friday

- AM 9:00aa-11:30am or PM 12:45pm-3:30pm
- **\$190 per month**
- Children must turn 4 on or before September 1st of the current school year.

Young 3's - 1 Day: Day and time varies

- **\$55 per month**
- Children must turn 3 by December 31st of the current year.
